Dear Parents/Carers,

At the last Parents' Forum meeting, it was pointed out that a number of children do not consistently wear the correct school uniform. Please refer to the online prospectus on the website for details of uniform expectations. In particular we have noticed that several children regularly wear jewellery to school—*No jewellery other than stud earrings and watches may be worn. Stud earrings should be removed during PE lessons.*

For PE children should be wearing *a pair of plain navy shorts, a blue or white tee shirt and plimsolls or trainers.*

Now that we are going into summer, *girls may wear blue and white check dresses or a blue/white tee shirt or blouse and navy blue skirt. Boys may wear grey or navy shorts.*
