Dear Parents/Carers,

The Year 3 and 4 Christmas performances are rapidly approaching. As last year, entry will be by ticket only. We are restricted on the number of seats that can safely be accommodated in the hall. Due to the number of activities and events taking place around the Christmas period, we are also restricted in the number of performances we can reasonably 'fit in'. Year 3 and 4 children will today bring home 1 ticket per family for the afternoon performance on 7th December and 1 ticket for the evening performance on 8th December. Each ticket will admit 1 person to the performance. We are anxious to fill the limited number of seats we can accommodate, so please return your ticket to the office if you know you will not be able to attend so that it can be re-allocated. At the bottom of this newsletter there is a slip to complete if you would like to request extra tickets, should any become available. Slips will be drawn 'from a hat' as demand is likely to exceed the number of spare tickets!

section). As in previous years, we will do our utmost to keep school open as we recognise the impact it has on the arrangements families have to make, as well as the impact on children's learning.
