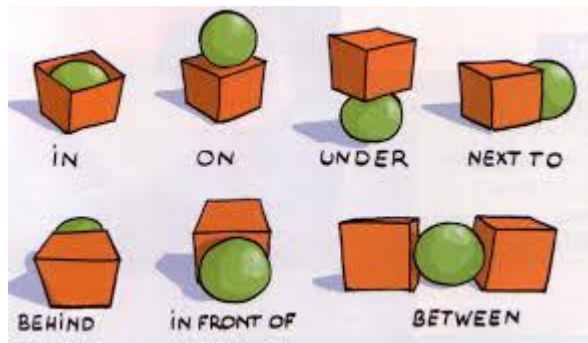

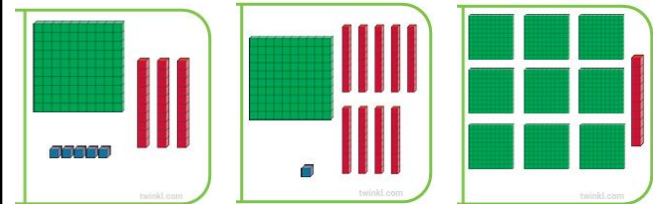

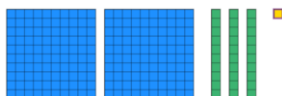
Challenge 1 – What numbers are represented?



Challenge 2 – Can you draw these numbers using dienes?

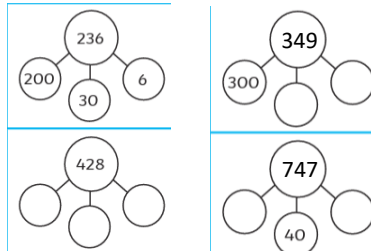

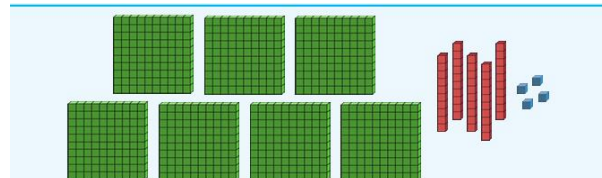
**This week – Maths**
